Notice of an infection in the class

Person who tested positive was present at school:
- On the day of testing without symptoms
OR
- Within 2 days before the COVID-related symptoms began

Student

Inform the students, parents and staff of the class(es) involved.

Students and employees are allowed to come to school or stay at school, awaiting the contact tracing (BCO) which will point out the close contacts who may go into quarantine.

Employee

Inform all employees about the infection (do not share the name unless there is no objection).

*If there's no objection to share the name: provisional **quarantine** is advised for employees who have been in contact for more than 15 minutes within 1.5m. This is regardless of their immunity.*
